JONES NOMINATED BY CONSERVATIVES IN ROYAL BY-ELECTION

Hampton, June 5 — At a largely attended open convention of the Liberal-Conservative Party of Royal (Kings-Queens) held in the Court House here, yesterday afternoon, Hon. George B. Jones, Apohaqui, who has represented the party for the last 24 years, half of which was spent in the provincial arena as members for Kings county and the latter half as member for Royal in the Dominion parliament, and who recently resigned his seat on finding he had committed a technical violation of the Independence of Parliament Act in the last election, was elected as standard-bearer of the party, for the ninth consecutive time, in the by-election of June 27.
