THISTLES WIN THE SERIES--
WON FROM ST. ANDREWS
WITH HUNDRED MAJORITY

The Thistle curlers on Saturday afternoon evening gave the St. Andrews Club a bad defeat, the score being 248 to 143. Of the fourteen rinks playing for St. Andrews only one of them proved a winner and that was shipped by P. A. Clarke, who on the Thistle ice in the afternoon won from Skip J. W. Cameron by a score of 12 to 11. This match finished the series for this season. The first match of the series was played on Saturday, January 31, and was captured by St. Andrews with a majority of 41 points, the total score being 224 to 187.

The second match was curling on Saturday, February 14th, and the Thistles won with a majority of 176 points, the total score being 219 to 176.

In the match last Saturday the Thistles finished the afternoon play with a total of 115 to 69, or 46 of a majority. This lead the Thistles increased with 54 in the evening, play giving them a majority of an even 100.
