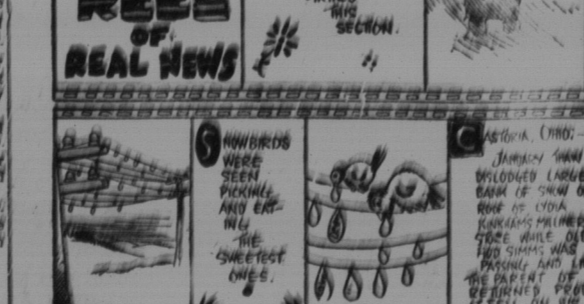
THE POLICE COURT
