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bond, covenant, contract or agreement made to or with the trustees, governors and fellows of Acadia College, and all persons shall have the power, any statute to the contrary notwithstanding, at any time to grant, devise, bequeath or convey by deed, will or otherwise, any real or personal property to the corporation hereby created, either for the purposes of the university generally or any department thereof, now or hereafter to be established, or for Horton Collegiate Academy or Acadia Seminary, or any other preparatory or academical or other department, or otherwise as may be provided by such grant, devise, bequest or conveyance.

4. All legal or other proceedings heretofore taken by or against the trustees, governors and fellows of Acadia College, may be continued under the same name or style of cause in which they have been instituted.

5. The Board of Governors may establish and manage professional and technical and other schools, and may support the same out of the funds of the university.

6. The Board of Governors shall have the power to grant degrees in theology and degrees of bachelor, master and doctor in the several arts, sciences and faculties, and any and all degrees which may properly be conferred by a university, and shall have the right to determine the courses of study, and the qualification for degrees and the granting of the same.

7. The Board of Governors shall have full power and authority to fix the number, residence, duties, salary, provision and emolument of the president, professors, principals, teachers, tutors, instructors, officers, agents and servants of said university, academy and seminary, and any other preparatory or academical or other department, and may also appoint the president, professors, principals, teachers, tutors, instructors, officers, agents and servants of said university, academy and seminary, and any other preparatory or academical or other department, and may from time to time remove the said president, professors, principals, teachers, tutors, instructors, officers, agents and servants, including those who at the passing of this act held any of said offices or positions under the acts hereby repealed.

8. The Board of Governors shall have the control and management of the property and funds of the said corporation and shall have power to adopt and carry into effect by-laws, resolutions and regulations touching and concerning the instruction, care, government and discipline of the students of said university, academy and seminary, and any other preparatory or academical or other department, and touching and concerning all other matters and
