COPY of a DESPATCH from Governor the Right Honourable Sir John Young, Bart., G.C.B., to The Earl Granville, K.G.

My Lord, Government House, Ottawa, 24 June 1869.

(Received, 7 July 1869.)

On the *20th instant I briefly acknowledged your Despatch of the 1st instant, adverting to the Minute approved by my predecessor, of the 27th of August last,† and making inquiries as to the alleged application of money raised under the Imperial guarantee for the construction of the Intercolonial Railway, to the purpose of defraying, temporarily, the general debts of the Dominion.

I send several additional copies of the papers which I enclosed, viz., correspondence respecting the Intercolonial Railway Loan, and Minutes of Council, of dates 29th May and 18th June. These documents furnish, on the part of the Privy Council of Canada, replies to the queries, as to what extent, and in what way, the loan has been employed under authority of the Minute of the 27th of August of last year, and contain the observations which Mr. Rose
