C A P. LXVIII.

An Act to amend so much of an Act of the Thirty-first Year of His late Majesty, as relates to the Election of Members to serve in the Legislative Assembly of the Province of *Upper Canada*.

[26th May 1826.]

THEREAS by an Act passed in the Thirty-first Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled An Act to repeal certain Parts of an Act passed in the 31 G. 3. c. 31. Fourteenth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled 'An Act for making ' more effectual Provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec ' in North America,' and to make further Provision for the Government of the said Province, it is amongst other Things enacted, that no Person shall be summoned to the Legislative Council in either of the Provinces of Upper Canada and Lower Canada who shall not be of the full Age of Twenty-one Years, and a natural-born Subject of His Majesty, or a Subject of His Majesty naturalized by Act of the British Parliament, or a Subject of His Majesty having become such by the Conquest and Cession of the Province of Canada; and it is thereby further provided, that no Person shall be capable of voting at any Election of a Member to serve in the Legislative Assembly in either of the said Provinces of Upper Canada or Lower Canada, or of being elected at any such Election, who shall not be of the full Age of Twenty-one Years, and a natural-born Subject of His Majesty, or a Subject
