C A P. LXVIII.

An Act to amend so much of an Act of the Thirty-first Year of His late Majesty, as relates to the Election of Members to serve in the Legislative Assembly of the Province of *Upper Canada*.

[26th May 1826.]

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the Thirty-first Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King *George* the Third, intituled *An Act to repeal certain Parts of an Act passed in the Fourteenth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled 'An Act for making more effectual Provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America,' and to make further Provision for the Government of the said Province,* it is amongst other Things enacted, that no Person shall be summoned to the Legislative Council in either of the Provinces of *Upper Canada* and *Lower Canada* who shall not be of the full Age of Twenty-one Years, and a natural-born Subject of His Majesty, or a Subject of His Majesty naturalized by Act of the *British* Parliament, or a Subject of His Majesty having become such by the Conquest and Cession of the Province of *Canada*; and it is thereby further provided, that no Person shall be capable of voting at any Election of a Member to serve in the Legislative Assembly in either of the said Provinces of *Upper Canada* or *Lower Canada*, or of being elected at any such Election, who shall not be of the full Age of Twenty-one Years, and a natural-born Subject of His Majesty, or a Subject
