An Act to amend the Act respecting duties of Customs and the collection thereof.

IN amendment of the Act respecting Duties of Customs and the col-pressible. lection thereof: Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:
