

An Act to amend the Act respecting duties of Customs and the collection thereof.

**[**IN amendment of the Act respecting Duties of Customs and the collection thereof: Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

Preamble.

- 5** **1.** The Governor in Council may, by Proclamation or Order in Council, at any time, and from time to time, prohibit the exportation or the carrying coastwise or by inland navigation, of the following goods:—  
Arms, Ammunition and Gunpowder, Military and Naval stores, and any articles which the Governor in Council shall judge capable of being
- 10** converted into or made useful in increasing the quantity of Military or Naval stores, Provisions or any sort of Victuals which may be used as the food of man; and if any goods so prohibited be exported, carried coastwise, or by inland navigation, or waterborne or laden in any Railway Carriage or other vehicle, for the purpose of being so exported or
- 15** carried, they shall be forfeited.

Exportation of arms, &c., may be prohibited by Order in Council.

**2.** All forfeitures incurred under this Act shall be held to be incurred under the said Act respecting duties of Customs and the collection thereof, of which this Act shall be held to form part, and any citation of the said Act shall be understood as including this Act.
