## CHAPTER 95.

## RIVER FISHERIES.

- Hereafter no salmon shall be taken in any of the rivers of this Time for province westward of the harbour of Halifax between the thirty-first day of July and the first day of March; nor in any river running into the Bay of Fundy, nor in any river in the Island of Cape Breton, nor in any river to the eastward of Halifax harbour, between the fifteenth day of August and the first day of March, except in salt water below low water mark and in salt water not later than the twentieth of Oc-Any person taking any salmon in any of the rivers of this Penalty. province within the times specified shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding forty dollars for every salmon taken by him.
- The sessions shall annually appoint such and so many places on Fisheries on the rivers and streams as may be attended with the least inconvenience rivers running to the owners of the soil, or the rivers, as resorts for the purpose of private lands, taking fish; but the same and the enactments herein contained shall &c. not extend to any species of fish taken from the sea except salmon, bass, shad, alewives, gaspereaux, trout and small mackerel.

- In cases where a river shall be the dividing line between two Sessions' counties the orders and regulations of the sessions in each county shall orders to have force and effect only to the centre of the channel of the river centre &c. being such dividing line.
- 4. The sessions shall from time to time make orders for the setting Sessions to and drifting of nets, the erecting and place of weirs, and generally for make orders for setting of the conducting of fisheries in all the bays, harbours, rivers, streams or nets, &c. creeks, or on the shores thereof, to be enforced by penalties not exceeding forty dollars for the breach of any such order.
- No bag nets shall be used for the purpose of taking salmon with-Penalties. in any river or harbour, not within a mile from the mouth of any river, Bag nets not and no nets shall be set or placed or allowed to remain set or placed Time when from one hour before sunset on Saturday night until an hour after sun-nets shall not rise on Monday morning.
