 - (b) The quorum required for such a meeting shall be one tenth of the total membership of the Students' Union as defined in Article II, Section1,
 - A special General Meeting of the Students' Union duly called

 (c) and constituted with the requirements of this section may, upon approval by a two-thirds majority of the Students' Union members present, rescind any motion of the Students' Union Council:
 - (d) Such meeting may, upon approval by a majority of the Students' Union members present, make recommendations to the Students' Council. Such recommendations, however, shall not be binding on the Students' Council."
