Gathering, your Great Father & Mother, has directed

of land ~~bound~~ ~~bound~~ contained in a line along
the Thimenset Bay, de Valaway river, nine miles
it intersects Lake Huron, or describes in a ^W N E S H E L D
which is now Munagon — N^o. 1 & 2 —
