With reference to your kind invitation to the Superintendent General to attend a large meeting of Indians at some central point within the territory covered by the above Treaty, with a view to a discussion of the same, you will observe from the explanation given above, that such a visit would be fruitless in its results, and therefore it is with regret that I have to say that a recommendation cannot be made to the Superintendent General to attend thereat as
