Mr. Inspector Green in his report on the Quamichan day school recommends that the name of this school be changed from Quamichan to Clemclemeluts for the reason that the school is on the Clemclemeluts reserve and not on the Quamichan.

Before making this change the Department would like a report from you. As you have already been informed, the Department has not recognized the Methodist school on the Quamichan reserve, and it has no intention of doing so at present.
