I beg to enclose herewith lists of implements, tools and school supplies that have been allowed in the Estimates 1912-1913 for your Agency.

You are authorized to purchase the implements and tools (Table A) as well as the hoes, cups, nails, brushes, axes, brooms and stoves for the schools.

You should obtain quotes for these articles from all the local recognized dealers and merchants of the district and make purchases in each case from the firm quoting the lowest prices.

The other school supplies mentioned on the list will be shipped to you from the Department's warehouse at Winnipeg, as well as the ammunition and traps.

The latter articles should be distributed to the various bands according to the quantities estimated by you.

The traps and fish for Manitoba Agency will be delivered under contract at the points mentioned in the schedule already furnished you and you should attend to the receipt and delivery of the same.
