
With Cheque.

Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 23rd ultimo, I enclose herewith cheque No. 4968 in payment of vouchers Nos. 550, 552, 553 and 554 in favor of Mr. R. H. Gilhuly for drugs supplied upon your order. Voucher No. 550 has been reduced from \$66.79 to \$64.16. The charges which occurred in several places in the account for corks, labels and bottling have been disallowed. This is the first time the Department has been asked to pay such charges and it is not proposed to pass them.

There was an error in the addition of voucher No. 552 which has been corrected. It was entered at \$115.00 but should be \$115.30.
