Ottawa, March 19, 1915.

Your Lordship,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 15th instant, in regard to the question of opening up road through the S. W. 1 of Sec. 28, Tp. 20, Rge. 23, W. 4th, by the local Government, and in reply to say that in Kovember last the Director of Surveys, Department of Public Works. Edmonton, was advised of the balance of principal and interest due on account of the purchase price of the portion of land comprised within the road on this quarter section, and requested when forwarding assignment from you to transmit the amount.

The local authorities have transmitted the proportionate amount of purchase price and interest to the Department, but have not as yet forwarded assignment, and the
Department, of course, will not recognize or transfer any
interest in this road allowance to the local authorities
until an assignment from you has been furnished as requested.
