Q.66 You haven't been back at all?

A.66 No. Sir.

- - In the opinion of the Court and the Judge Advocate it is not necessary to comply with the provisions of RP 83B.

THE WITNESS RESUMES HIS SEAT.

Defending Officer: No more witnesses, Sir, for the Defence.

Judge Advocate: The procedure then is for the Prosecutor to make a closing address and then the Defending Officer.
