Dear Sir:

I wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 21st submitting application of the Kelley Logging Company of 507 Randall Building, Vancouver, for permission to occupy about six acres of land and a road right of way on Lot 175, Skidegate Indian Reserve, at an annual rental of \$400.00.

In view of the consent of the Indian owners of this Reserve and your recommendation, permission is hereby granted the Kelley Logging Company to occupy this six acre parcel of land and road right of way for the period of one year from the date hereof, rental in the amount of \$400.00 having been received.

It is understood that this permit may be renewed from year to year upon application and during pleasure of the Minister, upon payment of a like annual rental.

This letter may be considered as authority to permit the Kelley Logging Company to occupy the camp site and right of way as above described.
