

GENERAL PROHIBITIONS.

The Indians should be reminded that by enactment of last session, head lights of any description are prohibited (Sec.11) and the use or possession of a magazine gun, which means a gun with more than one shot in the magazine and one in the breech, or an automatic^{gun} is illegal (Sec. 18.).

Firearms cannot be discharged in Vancouver and Victoria Harbours at any time (Sec.6) and deer cannot be sold at all on Vancouver Island, or adjacent islands (Sec. 21).

No person shall act as a guide without license (21 a. 1913.) This provision is said to be an advantage to the Indians, in providing a list of qualified guides for sportsmen.

By the Regulations wapiti are protected all over the Province, moose in Southeast Kootenay, and sheep in some districts. Running deer with dogs, or hunting birds with dogs between April 15th and August 1st, is also prohibited (Sec. 16).

Tuspaas
The Indian ~~trustee~~^{trustee} is ^{actually} aware that no person has any right to enter upon the Reserves to hunt or shoot.

FOR CONSIDERATION.

The Commission is respectfully reminded of the repeated requests of the Indians ~~that~~ for an amendment of the law which would enable them to shoot ducks which are not used by white people.
