- Q. You gave the correct statement as to the children to Mr Fougher when you made that statement up last year?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Where do the children go to school?
- A. None of them go to school now. I am the only boy who went to school. I went to Chilliwack seven years ago.
- Q. Was the evidence Rebert Selson gave in regard to the way the people make their living correct?
- A. Yes.
- Q. All his evidence was correct?
- A. All except one little thing. (Indicating on map) About where the river runs from that point that land at Ahkellah is not all very good land. Some of it is very good and some is very bad. There is nothing but swamp between the main river and the branch of the river and the little creek. About 200 yards off the mountain is a swampy place, but the rest of it across the river is sandy and not much good. There is no good land on the east side.

Commissioner McKenna: About how many acres of good land is there on the reserve altogether?

- A. I don't know.
- Q. Is a quarter of it good?
- A. I think about a quarter.
- Q. That is to the best of your knowledge and belief?
- A. Yes.
- Q. And you have been over it?
- A. Yes, I have been all over it.
- 4. And you swear that there is not half of it good land?
- A. Yes, I do.
- Mr Young: That is the only correction which you wish to make to the evidence of the last witness?
- A. Yes.

Commissioner MacDowall: (Indicating on map) You say this is all pretty good land in here? How is it here?

- A. That is no good.
- Q. How about that island?
- A. It is no good. It is a sandbar.
- Q. In here along the branch of the river is that good?
- A. Yes.
- Well now, if you were to add that to this part here(indicating) it means that nearly half of the reserve is good?
- A. Yes.
