## MEMORANDUM TO C.A.W.:

With reference to report by Mr. R. A. Joberty on the accident to Piper J3-C65, it is noted that he did not fly the above aircraft for hire or reward.

2. With reference to letter from D.I.A.R., Edmonton, dated February 23rd, 1948 (folio 157), you will note that Mr. Joberty was involved in an accident which might be attributable to an error in judgment with the result that the aircraft was seriously damaged. This would call for the issue of an official warning in the ordinary course of events but it is believed that, under the circumstances, no further action need be taken to acquaint the pilot with his responsibility in observing all precautions required by the ordinary practice of the air, etc.
