COST OF JOINING

Fees Payable by Charter Members

1. A Charter Fee of \$60.00, (if there be 20 Charter Members, each would pay towards the Charter \$3.00).
2. A Medical Examination Fee. This Fee to be paid by the Applicant Direct to the Examining Physician, and shall not be less than \$1.00 for \$500 or \$1,000 Insurance.
3. The High Court Medical Fee is 25 cents.
4. Certificate Fee, \$500 or \$1,000 insurance, \$1.00.

Each beneficiary member shall pay on or before the first day of each month, for that month, the following sums according to age at the time of his admission into the Order:
