were proposed, and the time and cause of any Member ceasing to belong to the Institute.

3d. Minute books for the Committee, for the respective Classes, and for the entry of proceedings at General Meetings of the Institute.

4th. A register of donations.

5th. Letter books.

6th. A register of rewards, which shall also contain the titles of the subjects given for competition.

The books of the Institute shall be at all times open for the inspection of any Senior Member.

The original of any paper, after having been submitted to the Society, and received, shall be considered as the property of the Institute, but the author may have a copy by leave of the Committee.

There shall be framed, as soon as circumstances shall permit, any part or the whole of the following institutions and collections.
