An Act to provide for the improvement
and management of the Harbour of
Three Rivers.

(Assented to 17th May, 1882.)

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WHEREAS, it is expedient to provide for the Preamble
improvement and management of the Har-
bour of Three Rivers: Therefore Her Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate
and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as
follows:—

1.—The Harbour of Three Rivers shall, for Extend and
Boundaries of

the purpose of this Act, comprise that part of the
Rivers St. Lawrence and St. Maurice lying
between a line drawn from the east side of the
mouth of the River St. Maurice to a point on the
south side of the River St. Lawrence directly
opposite, the said line being parallel to the
westerly boundary line of the city of Three
Rivers and a line drawn from the said westerly
boundary line of the city of Three Rivers to a
point on the south side of the River St. Lawrence
to be established by producing the said boundary
line to the south side of the River St. Lawrence,
together with both sides of the River St. Maurice
and the islands therein situated up to the north-
erly boundary line of the said City of Three
Rivers where it crosses the River St. Maurice;
and shall include all the water space and beach
up to tidal high water, on both sides of the said
rivers.
