FOR YOUNG WOMEN'S AND SENIOR CIRCLES

EASTER, A MESSAGE AND A PROMISE, is an Easter service consisting of three verses from a poem by Richard Watson Gilder, to be recited or read alternately with the singing of a beautiful Easter hymn, music of which is given. A second hymn also is on the sheet.....5c.

THE LIVING CHRIST is a beautiful responsive service, being texts grouped under The Living Christ Foretold, Made Flesh, Risen and Glorified, and using the hymn "There is no name so sweet on earth," printed on the sheet3c. each, 25c. doz.

EASTER MESSAGE, contains poems and messages for the Easter meeting....5c.

EASTER TIDINGS, is a little poem printed prettily on a card, which makes a dainty Easter greeting, or good for reading in Easter meeting2c.
