

RESOLVED, that the Bill do pass, and that the title be, an Act further to continue the Acts therein mentioned, for making a temporary provision for the regulation of Trade between this Province and the United States of *America*, by land or inland navigation.

ORDERED, that Mr. *Mure* do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

An engrossed Bill, for declaring Judges to be disabled, and disqualifying them, from being elected, or from sitting and voting, in the House of Assembly, was read for the third time.

On motion of Mr. *Debartzch*, seconded by Mr. *Bowen* :

RESOLVED, that the Bill do pass, and that the title be, an Act for declaring Judges to be disabled, and disqualifying them, from being elected, or from sitting or voting, in the House of Assembly.

ORDERED, that Mr. *Debartzch* do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.
