- **RESOLVED**, that the Bill do pafs, and that the title be, an Act further to (continue the Acts therein mentioned, for making a temporary provision for the regulation of Trade between this Province and the United States of *America*, by land or inland navigation.
- ORDERED, that Mr. Mure do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and defire their concurrence.

An engrofied Bill, for declaring Judges to be difabled, and difqualifying them, from being elected, or from fitting and voting, in the Houfe of Affembly, was read for the third time.

On motion of Mr. Debartzeb, seconded by Mr. Bowen;

- RESOLVED, that the Bill do pafs, and that the title be, an Act for declaring Judges to be difabled, and difqualifying them, from being elected, or from fitting or voting, in the House of Assembly.
- ORDERED, that Mr. Debartzch do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and defire their concurrence.

The order of the day for the House to refolve itself into a Committee of the whole House, on the Melfage from His Excellency the Governor in Chief to this House, on the thirteenth instant, intimating that *Pierre* Bedard, Esquire, elected to serve as a Member for the County of Surrey, was apprehended and committed for treasonable practices, being read;

The House accordingly resolved itself into the faid Committee.

Mr. Speaker left the Chair.

Mr. Debartzch took the Chair of the Committee.

Mr. Speaker refumed the Chair;

And Mr. Debartzch reported, that the Committee had made further progrefs, and had directed him to move for leave to fit again.
