The Bill, entitled, An Act for applying certain Monies therein mentioned; for 'the fervice of the year of Our Lord one thouland eight hundred and twelve, and for appropriating fuch part of the Supplies granted in this Seffion of the General Affembly, as are not already appropriated by the Laws or the Acts of the Province, feverally, without any amendment.

And then the Meffenger withdrew.

A Meffage from the Council, by Mr. Cogfwell : Mr. Speaker,

The Council have agreed to the refolution of this Houfe of the 25th March last, That the Members of His Majefly's Council, and the Houfe of Affembly, not already provided with the Laws of the Province, be furnished each with a fet at the expense of the Province.

An Act to authorife the Commanding Engineer at Halifax, to enclose a part of the Highway, leading from Fort Masley to the Exercising Ground, on the Common of Halifax.

An Act to alter the time of the fitting of the Inferior Court of Common Pleas for the County of Halifax.

An Act to alter the time of the fitting of the Inferior Court of Common. Pleas, and General Seffions of the Peace in the County of Hants.
