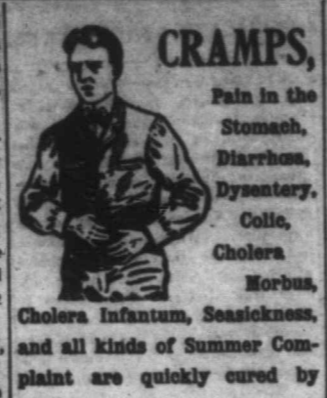

Congress of Catholic Chippewa Indians.

The first annual congress of the Catholic Chippewa Indians took place June 17, 1903, at White Earth Reservation, Minnesota. The occasion that brought together nearly all the branches of the Chippewa nation, among whom nearly five thousand are Catholics, was the thirty-fifth anniversary of their settlement in Minnesota, effected by the great chief Siole in the Day. The first day—the 15th—was set apart for the civic celebration, consisting of a parade after which addresses were made by Governor Van Zant, Lieutenant Governor Jones, of Minnesota and Rev. Dr. Gans, representing the Catholic Indian schools and missions. The second day was given to a banquet upon which were served a variety of native dishes and boat and pony races.
