MONTREAL.
A Murdered Man's Widow Brings Action for Damages Against the Father of the Murderer—The Province Free From Small-pox—The Gas Works.

Mr. Badger, associating with Dr. Girard, has visited the Gas Works at Hochelaga to unravel the mystery of the bad gas. He says it was all due to a leaky pipe running from the works, which allowed the atmosphere to be drawn in; the air acting on outside of iron in purifiers extracted sulphur previously already purified gas in the gasometer as well as thoroughly igniting the water in which boilers float.

Dame Margaret Dumphy, widow of the late Thomas Dumphy, victim of the murderer, Jack Kehoe, has taken an action for \$1,000 against the latter's father, Lawrence Kehoe. There was no marriage contract between Jack Kehoe's father and mother, and he as an only child became heir when she died. By the sentence of death passed upon him, Jack Kehoe lost all his civil rights, and his father stepped upon his estate with all its liabilities. For this reason present action is now taken against Lawrence Kehoe to recover damages on account of the death of his son's victim.

A telegram was received by the police authorities today from Louis Schelsinger, Toronto, saying while in this city yesterday he lost \$300. It appears that Mr. Schelsinger, who belongs to New York, came to Montreal at the beginning of the week, and before leaving for Toronto he decided to go up the elevator in the new building of the New York Life Insurance Co. He carried with him a large sum of money, which he believed fell from his pockets when he was on the hoist. Detective Barrett made an examination of the premises and hoist, but no money was found.

C. C. Delorimer, Q. C., has been made a Judge of the Superior Court at Joliet, with residence in Montreal, and promised the first French vacancy on the city bench. Judge Ouimet is transferred from Sorrel to Montreal.

The Way of the Transgressor.
Springfield, Ohio, December 6.—Eighteen months ago Henry C. Layburn, a prominent business man and a member of the Council of this city, to avoid arrest for a series of alleged forgeries, amounting to several thousand dollars, fled from his home, a fugitive from justice ever since. Early this week he was called home by his sick wife, and to-day, while he was ministering to her, he was arrested here. In defiance to his wife's condition Layburn was held at his home. The officer grimly waited for his prisoner, who sat with his wife in his arms, until he breathed his last he was arrested to jail.

For the Benefit of the Working People.
Washington, Dec. 6.—Senator Blair introduced a bill providing that there shall be established by the President, on the recommendation of the Commissioner of Labor, throughout the United States in geographical sections which shall include a population of not less than 100,000 nor more than 200,000 inhabitants, bureaus of information relating to employment, occupations, wages, means of livelihood, etc. It is made the duty of these bureaus to gather complete and reliable information relative to the people, the wages, the opportunities for employment and the general conditions of the people, and to make every effort to bring it to the attention of working people.

American Association of Base Ball Clubs.
St. Louis, Dec. 6.—At the meeting of the American Association of Base Ball Clubs to-day, the reduced salary schedule adopted by the League at its meeting last month was favorably discussed and a committee appointed to report on the same at the meeting of the Association to be held in March next. The proposition to cut down the schedule of games from 140 to 120 was defeated. The committee appointed to secure the services of umpires was instructed to reduce its expenditure in that direction, and it is predicted the result will be a new set of umpires.

Charged with Having Murdered His Daughter.
Birmingham, Ala., Dec. 6.—R. R. Hawes has been arrested on the charge of having murdered his daughter. May last he was married to a young woman in Columbus, Miss., yesterday, and was arrested immediately on his arrival here with his bride. He denies all knowledge of the crime. The body of the young girl was found in East Lake on Tuesday last.

Six Sailed in One Day.
New York, December 6.—A lady guest at the Grand Hotel, who registered as Mrs. E. Devillers, Frederick, Md., shot herself in the mouth yesterday. She will die. No cause is assigned for the deed. Five other suicides occurred in this city to-day.

GENERAL CABLE NEWS.
A STEAMER WRECKED AND 17 LIVES LOST.

Another Agrarian Murder in Ireland—Belgian strikers Use Dynamite and attempt to Wreck a Railway Train—Labor Riots in France—Arabia Fire on British Troops at Suakin Important Statement by Premier—People-The Native Rising in East Africa Spreading—The Boulangerists Growing Uneasy—Mr. Bright's Condition Worse.

The King of Portugal is ill. Lord Randolph Churchill will in a short time start on a visit to South America. The British steamer Hartwood has been wrecked at Egersund, Norway. Only four of her crew of 21 were saved. Riotous strikes have occurred among workmen at Rennes, Department of Ille et Vilaine, France. Troops have been sent there. An accident has occurred on the railway between Marzeilles and Toulon, France, which it is believed was attended with serious results.

A Zanzibar despatch says:—The German ship Carola has captured a slave ship. The rising among the natives along the Coast is increasing. The elections for members of the Norwegian Storting have resulted in the victory of the Conservatives, 37 Liberal and 22 Ministerialists.

John Bright has rallied somewhat. Later Mr. Bright's condition is worse to-night. He is daily becoming weaker. A doctor is attending to him to-day and night. Advice from Suakin state that the Arabs yesterday opened fire on the detachment of British troops that arrived by the steamer Hode Ida, but they were soon silenced.

A farmer named Cunningham was murdered to-day near Banbridge. The crime resulted from agrarian troubles. Three persons have been arrested in connection with the affair. A petition is being signed among the directors of the Grand Trunk and Canadian Pacific to terminate hostility and come to friendly traffic arrangements.

The French Chamber of Deputies to-day approved the report of the Committee recommending that M. Wilson be presented to the Chamber by the name of the Right did not vote on the question. Arrangements have been made at Brisbane for an international sculling contest. The first prize will be £700. Bench, Military service is made compulsory. The Shah of Persia has expressed his willingness that Russian consuls shall reside at Rehd, but objects to the consular jurisdiction extending to Meshed, because that place is a holy city. The Persian authorities in the interior, who received 302 votes against 133 cast for Herr Schneider (Liberal).

The Vatican notifies former sovereigns of Italian States that the Pope cannot long prevent Catholics from taking part in elections. At a conference of the Sacred College, at which the Pope presided, it was decided to allow Catholics entire liberty of action. The new Servian constitution declares the Kingdom hereditary, with popular representation and the religion Greek, with the Eastern Servian Church autocephalous. The electoral franchise is granted to persons paying direct taxes of fifteen dinars yearly (the dinar being equal to a French franc). The tribunals are to be independent, and the Judges are to be irremovable. Military service is made compulsory. The strike movement in Belgium is increasing and the strikers are everywhere becoming reckless. An attempt was made to-day to wreck a train on the Halloo-vue railway, dynamite cartridges being placed on the track. Fortunately the cartridges were discovered in time to prevent a disaster. An attempt to blow up a manufactory at Morlanwez with dynamite also failed.

The North German Gazette denies that German officers are acting as spies in France. The paper mentions 13 French officers who were staying in Germany on the presence of staying in the language, and who were expelled between Sept. 22 and Nov. 17, it having been discovered that the real object was to gain information concerning German military affairs. The French Government, the Gazette declares, had been officially notified that the presence of French officers in Germany was not desired, and expresses the hope that in future there will be a better compliance with the notification.

In the Italian Senate to-day General Corio asked what the intentions of the Government were regarding Massowah, and for information as to the relations between Italy and France. Signor Crispi, the Prime Minister, in reply, said that the expedition to the Red Sea was undertaken when he was not in power. Still, he did not think the Government would be satisfied with the result. In regard to the relations between France and Italy, Signor Crispi said:—Our relations with France, which lately were not entirely satisfactory, are now only good, but cordial and friendly. Nothing justifies the supposition that a war with France is probable or near. Nevertheless, in view of the situation in Germany, Italy cannot dream of disarming. On the contrary, owing to her special position and her engagements, she must labor to perfect her armaments.

In the French Chamber of Deputies this evening M. Larose, who is a friend of M. Ferry's and who favors severe anti-Boulangerist measures, having intimated his desire to move a lack of confidence in the Cabinet, Premier Floquet said the Government was quite ready to meet him. M. Larose replied that he would introduce his motion at the proper time. In the course of his speech the Premier announced that the ministry were engaged in drafting a bill of the highest importance, which would soon be introduced.
