ENGLISH TURF.

THE ASCOT SUMMER MEETING.

Ascot, June 11.—The Alexandra Plate, of 1,000 sovs, added to a sweepstakes of 25 sovs each, half forfeit, for four-year-olds and upwards; four-year-olds to carry 126 lbs; five-year-olds, 132 lbs; six-year-olds and aged, 133 lbs; mares and geldings allowed 4 lbs; winners of any stakes or prize worth 2,000 sovs, in any country, in 1874-5, or of the Ascot, Goodwood, or Doncaster Cups, or Alexandra Plate, in 1874-5, to carry 5 lbs extra; maiden four-year-olds, at the time of starting, allowed 7 lbs; five-year-old and upwards, 10 lbs; horses foaled out of Europe allowed 7 lbs; pure Arabs and Arabians allowed 28 lbs; and no other allowances; the second horse received 200 sovs out of the stakes, and the third saved his stake; to start at the new mile post and once around; about three miles. Seven horses started for this race, which is one of the very few long-distance races remaining on the English turf.
