Railway certificates, entitling members to reduced fares, will be sent in due time.

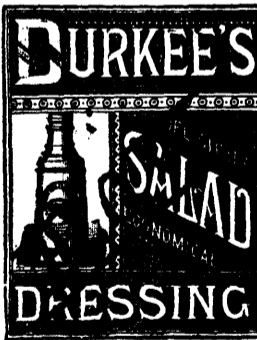
