But whether Canada will ever consent to give up her separate nationality, even for such a prospect of greatness, and whether even were such consolidation consummated, it would be of advantage to the Empire in general, are questions not to be answered here. But if such a result ever does occur, not the least important factor in it will be the visit of Prince George, Duke of Cornwall and York.
