

With the Ditcher Scoop - -

The Keystone Excavator, Model 4, is the most flexible of all steam shovels. Four different scoops can be supplied, all being readily interchangeable. As shown above, the machine is equipped with a 30-inch ½yard Ditcher Scoop for digging ditches, water ways, aqueducts, also foundation work down to 18 feet. The Excavator itself stays on the level, backing up, taking the ditch or excavation with it, drag-line fashion. Loads a 1½-yd. wagon in about two minutes. Capacity, 150 to 300 cubic yards per day. Note the sturdy, ground gripping outriggers giving extra rigidity to the Keystone. Skimmer Scoop is used for road work, Dipper Scoop for side hill and gravel pit work and Clam Shell Bucket for loose material. Will handle the toughest, boiler-strewn soil—has 32 h.p. steam engine, travels, under its own power, weight 12 tons, ideal for municipal work.
