Format: The Canada-Taiwan Business Association (CTBA) is a private sector, bilateral organization established to further business relations and enhance bilateral trade between Canada and Taiwan. The major activity of the CTBA is the annual joint conference held alternately between Taiwan and Canada. Sessions on general issues and workshops organized along sector lines provide a forum for airing concerns and improving communications between the two economies. The last meeting of the CTBA was held in Taiwan, April 1-3 1990.

The CTBA is administered in Canada by the Canadian Chamber of Commerce and in Taiwan by the Chinese National Association of Industry and Commerce.
