facilitate wherever possible, full access to organizations which are outside the system of higher educational establishments.

- 2. Both sides agreed to encourage and facilitate touristic travel within their borders of exchangees under the present programme (including annexes B and C) by the granting of discount fares normally available to their own nationals.
- 3. The financial and administrative provisions for exchanges as per paragraphs A-1, B-1 and B-2 are shown in Annex A.

## II

## EXCHANGES IN THE FIELD OF ARCTIC SCIENCES

- 1. Both sides agreed to continue with a programme of exchange as agreed to under the <u>Protocol of Canadian</u>

  Soviet Consultations on the <u>Development of a Programme of Scientific and Technical Cooperation in the Arctic and the North which was signed in Moscow on April 16, 1984.</u>
- 2. The Canadian side informed the Soviet side of the continued interest of the province of Quebec in cooperating with the RSFSR in the field of Arctic sciences and northern development.
