Chemical and Bacteriological (Biological) Warfare:  
Draft United Nations General Assembly Resolution

To facilitate consideration at the XXIV United Nations General Assembly of that part of the Report of the ENDC on chemical and bacteriological (biological) warfare, the Canadian Delegation submits the following draft resolution which has been developed from the remarks made by the Canadian Representative at the 424th meeting of the Committee on 31 July 1969. The draft resolution takes into account the Report of the Secretary-General on chemical and bacteriological (biological) weapons and the effects of their possible use (A/7575 of 1 July 1969), the proposals of delegations, especially those of the Delegation of Poland, on this Report, the draft Convention on the Prohibition of Biological Methods of Warfare submitted by the Delegation of the United Kingdom (ENDC/255 of 10 July 1969) as well as other views advanced by various delegations on this subject during the 1969 session of the Committee.

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
