VI. That the sums provided in articles 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of Section Second be increased twenty-five per cent per annum.

VII. Your Committee recommends, which is all they feel can be done at present, that the Quarterly Boards do make a liberal, yea, generous allowance for all the expenses of the Preachers' Families, such as Board, Fuel, Servants, Physicians' Bills, House Rent, Horse Keeping, &c., so that our Preachers may be placed at least on a par with those of all other denominations, and relieved from the harassing cases of providing for their families in pecuniary matters, which so often sadly interfere with ministerial duties, and lessen ministerial influence.
