

the amount to which he is entitled. Copies are subjoined of the Forms in which these lists and certificates should be drawn up. The lists will be forwarded by the Colonial Department; and for that purpose they should be sent there, at least three weeks before the departure of the Emigrants, under a cover marked with the word "Emigration," and addressed to "The Under Secretary of State, Colonial Department, London." At the same time should be enclosed the acknowledgment of Messrs. Smith, Payne, and Smiths, for the payment to the account of the Governor, without which acknowledgment no list will be sent forward. Neither can any list be forwarded, or the management of a deposit in the present manner be undertaken, unless the whole sum deposited by the individual signing the list amount at the least to 50^l. The certificates must be delivered to the several parties to whom they relate; but they should be sealed up, and addressed to "The Agent for Emigrants at Quebec," or "at Montreal."
