## BILL.

An Act respecting proof of entries in Books of Account kept by Officers of the Crown.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Preamble. Senate and House of Commons, enacts as follows :--

I. A copy of any entry in any book of account kept by Copies to be any officer of the Crown shall, in all courts established by prima faci-5 the Parliament of Canada and in all legal proceedings civil contents of and criminal over which the Parliament of Canada has <sup>entries.</sup> legislative authority, be received as *primâ-facie* evidence of such entry and of the matters, transactions and accounts therein recorded if it is proved :-

(a.)
