

SECTION IV.**COMMITTEES.**

1. The General Committee shall have power to make By-laws for conducting the business of meetings of the Association; shall select subjects, and make appointments for all regular meetings, and shall be responsible for the due and regular supply of the periodicals, &c.

2. Their meetings shall be held at least once a month, five members forming a quorum, and they may appoint one of their number as permanent Secretary of Committee.

3. They shall submit to the Association at the annual meeting, a list of periodicals, &c., recommended to be supplied for the succeeding year, and shall at that meeting present a report upon the business of the year.

4. Special Committees of not less than three members may be appointed for any purpose, and such committees shall continue in office until discharged by vote of the Association.

5. The member first named on such committee shall be the Convenor thereof, but the committee may, at its first meeting, appoint a Chairman and Secretary; a majority of the Committee shall constitute a quorum.

6. The Minutes of every such Committee shall be kept in the Special Committee Minute Book, which shall be deposited with the Secretary of the Association, as soon as the Committee has reported.
