

every member), for receiving the Treasurer's accounts of the receipts and disbursements, and for general business ; and that any alterations proposed to be made in the Rules and Regulations shall be communicated one week prior to such meeting.

XI.—That the Season shall commence on the 1st of May, and that the Club shall continue to meet on every Tuesday and Friday until the 31st of October.

XII.—That the crew of the boat shall select their own Captain for the time being, and all members of the crew will be expected to obey him most implicitly ; in the event of a refusal, a fine of 10s. cy., will be most rigidly enforced.

XIII.—That a committee nominated at a General Meeting be empowered to make all such arrangements, with reference to buying of boats, &c., general expenses and concerns of the Club, as are not specially mentioned in the foregoing Rules.

XIV.—That the power of arranging matches be vested in the Committee ; but that such matches shall not take place on either of the Club Days, if they can be arranged otherwise.

XV.—That if any member should be selected to row in a match, and shall have consent-
