

The qualifications which entitle a oter to be on the list for the forthoming Dominion elections are, that

1. A male person of 21 years.
2. A British subject.
3. A resucent of Canada 12 months before the day for commencing the making of the list.
4. A resident of the city of London on that day and for three months preceding, and of the electoral district of London on that day and for 30 days next preceding.
And in addition those who case special ballots as provided in the military votters' act.
Female voters, qualified as to age, nationality and residence as above.

BRITISH CAPTURE 2,038.

London, Oct. 10.—The official communication issued by the British war office tonight reads:

"In the course of the day hostile attacks against our new positions in the region of the Ypres-Staden Railway led to local fighting, but without affecting any material change in the situation. No further attacks have been made by the enemy, and our troops on the battlefront, in spite of the great difficulties arising from the state of the ground. The arrestillery activity continued on both sides.
