Sir,-

When you have completed your work in the Carlton Agency, I have to request you to confer with the Hon, Mr. Laird, who will give you detailed instructions in connection with a piece of land in Township No. 28, Range 1, West of the 1st Meridian, which requires to be surveyed, properly posted and the usual plan and field notes thereof made. It is intended to have this land added to the Fisher River Indian reserve. I should add that a connection should be made by survey with some Dominion Land Survey, or with the present Fisher River Indian reserve boundaries, or with both, if the same can be done without great trouble.

posed addition is enlossed herewith. It would appear that the locality can be easily reached by cance from the mouth of the river. In any case it is considered that you should be able to obtain all the assistance you require and means for transportation at the said reserve, and that there will be no necessity for you to incur the expense of bringing your party and outfit from your present location.
