The above mentioned Indian woman appeared before Magistrate C.W. HAWKSHAW, in County Court at London, Ont., on the a.m. of the 12th instant, charged under Section 272 of the Criminal Code.

Sub-Division

The case was heard on the 6th instant when the accused and her two sons Clarence and Tommy ANDREWS pleaded guilty, through their counsel Mr. J.M. DONOHUE. The Magistrate remanded the accused parties until the 13th instant for sentence.

Detachment

In the case of Mrs. Lillian DOCKSTATER the Magistrate imposed a sentence of four months definite and two months indefinite to be served in the reformatory.

4. In the cases of Clarence and Tommy ANDREWS suspended sentence of two years, was meted out in both cases.
