FARM LABORERS EXCURSIONS TO THE WEST

With the promise of a bumper crop in the west, the governments of Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta have called on Eastern Canada for 100,000 thousand harvest help laborers to assist them in saving the harvest. The Canadian Government Railway will sell harvesters tickets to Winnipeg from all stations in the Maritime Provinces, Tuesday, August 17th, and Tuesday, August 24th, to Winnipeg, at very low rates, the fare from Moncton to Winnipeg being \$18.50, and the fare from other stations will be in proportion.

This route will run via Intercolonial to Montreal, Grand Trunk to North Bay, Temiskaming and Northern Ontario to Coburne, thence Transcontinental to Winnipeg.

Rates based on half a cent per mile may be obtained at all points west in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta. Returning tickets will be issued to bona-fide excursionists at very low rates. 8-17
