At the conclusion of the hearing yesterday afternoon into the loss of the schooner Maid of Scotland by collision with the steamer Perene, Capt. A. L. Demers, Dominion Wreck Commissioner, ordered that the certificate of the master of the Perene, Capt. Ewart White, be taken away temporarily. Doubt Regarding Jurisdiction.


