



'an J. Edwards, H. M. senior trade nmissioner for Canada and Newfoundard, for an exhibition of raw products of mindia, which will be shown at the decommissioner's offices in St. James cet during July.

A cable was yesterday received by pt. Plwards from the director-general commercial intelligence of the Indian vernment at Calcutta, stating that he i arranged for the collection and fording to the trade commissioner's offices of Indian products. These will sist primarily of raw materials, used Canadian manufacturing work, such

as hides, skins, jute, hemp, kapok, oil seeds, certain chemical products indigenous to India, tanned stuffs, lace, chicane work and a number of other purely Indian products.

These exhibits are being sent here by the Indian government, at the suggestion of Capt. Edwards, with the object of increasing trade between Canada and India. The materials for these exhibits are being supplied by a number of Indian firms, both British and native, with the idea of booming Indian trade generally, and not of advertising any particular firm.
