The City Baseball League executive is to meet this evening to draw up a schedule for the year, decide on the ball to be used, and arrange other details necessary for the opening on May 24.

St. Peter's ball park will be ready for the opening. There is still some finishing touches necessary to get the infield in condition, but this should be done in a few days. A bleacher is in the course of construction and is a strong commodious structure capable of holding 450 fans.

The hill to the south of the ball field is a natural bleacher and will accommodate more than 1,000 fans. If all goes well next year a grandstand will be erected behind home plate.

The inauguration of daylight saving time will mean a big boost for the game in these parts. Without the extra hour of daylight teams would have a hard time getting in four or five innings, but now during the summer many nine inning contests should be enjoyed.

Covey and other sport enthusiasts behind the movement there is no doubt that it will be a success.
